We have been serving as the Club's trip co-coordinators since the 2009/2010 season.

It is time for us to pass the torch on this position and our tenure will end with this ski season.

If you are interested in taking on the position, please contact us or any member of the board. Trip planning for the 2025-2026 season will start next April and we will be happy to assist during the transition for the new season.

The duties of the trip director include:

- Explore possible locations for trips next ski season with board/member input for trip locations.
- Contact mountain reps and ski tour reps to explore lift ticket and lodging options.
- Submit trip budgets to the board for approval.
- Recruit trip captains for the selected trips.
- Contract with the various sites and tour operators for the selected trips and coordinate payment dates with the treasurer.
- Monitor trip sign ups and adjust lodging as required.
- Order lift tickets and assist trip captains with the trip details.

Assist treasurer with member sign ups and expenses.

The position is compensated with trip credit for the year following the term based on skier numbers and board approval.

It has been an interesting experience in this role, and we have made friends with people from other clubs and reps from both the mountains and tour operators.

The rep from Tour de Sport skied with us at Snowmass two years ago and told us that it was the most fun she experienced skiing with a client. She let us lead and we did runs she loves but would have never been allowed to lead a client down.

TRIP INSURANCE

It's been said that trip insurance is never needed until it's needed.

What should you know about trip insurance?

- You must purchase trip insurance coverage <u>before</u> it is needed. Once
 you recognize the need, it is too late to protect your trip.
- After the initial trip payment is made and you have a good grasp of your total expected trip cost, it is good time to get the most accurate quote.
- An example of coverage for a \$1,500 trip within the United States for a 60-year-old is approximately \$63 through www.insuremytrip.com.
- If you need coverage for a pre-existing medical condition, there
 are time-sensitive eligibility requirements tied to your initial trip
 payment and you may have a limited amount of time to buy a
 plan.



Snowmass is known for lots of powder days and "bluebird" skies. Three other mountains are also available on the same lift ticket with FREE bus service to them: Aspen Mountain (Ajax) with the town of Aspen at the base; Aspen Highlands; and Buttermilk/Tiehack. All four mountains are easily accessible and great fun to ski. Only skiing for three days? Have a day of fun in Aspen (shopping, tours, lunch, etc.) or take the free bus to Glenwood Springs to enjoy the hot springs and spa.

We have the ideal lodging! Tamarack is in a great location with high quality and numerous amenities.

DATES: Check in is Saturday, December 7, 2024, for 5 nights of lodging. Check out Thursday morning, December 12, 2024.

SKI DATES: Sunday, December 8, through Wednesday, December 11

BASIC TRIP PRICE: \$590.00, includes lodging only. This trip is full but we may be able to add spots if we can fill a condo. Call Jim.

Transportation is on your own. Consider carpooling.

LODGING: Tamarack Townhomes 2-bedroom/ 2-bath condos. There is a pool and two hot tubs in the complex. These units are right across the street from the lower base area of Snowmass. The 6-chair lift is located at this base area. The gondola is also within walking distance that travels towards the Elk Camp area. A 4-person foot traffic lift ("Skittles") takes us to the Village Mall where there are many restaurants and shops to explore.

Ski rental is also in the lower base area.

LOCAL TRANSPORTATION & GROCERIES:

A Village shuttle stop is right by the condos and the free bus service to the other mountains and Aspen is just across the street. A grocery store is within walking distance.

Flatland Ski Association Trip January 25 - 31 (Saturday-Friday), 2025

Telluride is located at the end of a canyon and surrounded by Colorado's most rugged peaks. Most people do not travel this far so there are hardly any lift lines. This is our annual adventure with friends of the Flatland Ski Association (FSA).

Telluride gets an amazing amount of powder every year. They have 125 runs over 2,000 acres. For those tracking their vertical feet the longest run is 24,288 ft! 23% of runs are easy, 36% of runs are intermediate and 41% difficult. (What a nice mix!) Also, great skiing for families.

There is also snowshoeing, sleigh rides, fat tire bike tours, sledding, horseback riding, dog sledding and more. These activities would also be fun for those who want a new experience on their non-ski day! (For the more adventurous there is also heli-skiing. Telluride also has an amazing ski town, ranking alongside Park City & Aspen.

<u>DATES</u>: Check in is Saturday, January 25, 2025, for 6 nights of lodging. Check out Friday morning, January 31, 2025.

SKI DATES: Sunday, January 26, through Thursday, January 30.

BASIC TRIP PRICE: \$1,260.00, includes lodging only and FSA activity pass for racing/meal(s). Full payment is due at November 19 meeting.

Transportation to/from Telluride is on your own. Flying is ideal; or consider carpooling. Parking is \$35/day. The destination airport is MTJ (Montrose) if you fly. This is about 65 miles from the resort.

NEW: AIRPORT SHUTTLE OPPORTUNITY:

FSA has arranged group shuttle transportation from Montrose Airport to Mountain Lodge Telluride for \$126.00 per person round-trip. To participate, your inbound flight must be scheduled to <u>arrive</u> by 3:00 p.m. January 25 and your outbound flight must be scheduled to depart <u>after</u> 10:00 a.m. January 31. To sign up, add \$126.00 to the total price of your trip.

This resort does have ski in/out access and a ski shuttle. Amenities include free Wi-Fi, babysitting, bar, lounge, dining, outdoor pool & hot tub. A grocery store is within walking distance.

CORNHUSKER SKI CLUB TRIP POLICIES

- Membership is mandatory to participate in trips organized by the Cornhusker Ski Club. A completed and signed Cornhusker Ski Club membership form must be submitted with membership dues payable to Cornhusker Ski Club.
- To reserve a place on the trip, a deposit must be given to the Trip Captain with checks payable to the Cornhusker Ski Club. \$15 of the deposit is non-refundable in the event that you cancel your participation on the trip for any reason.
- The balance of the trip fee is due according to announced schedules. If the Trip Captain does not have payment by these dates, your name will be dropped and your reservation filled from the waiting list.
- Once a trip is filled, no deposit is required to place your name on a waiting list.
- 5. Trip cancellations or changes will be accepted by the Trip Captain up to 90 days <u>prior</u> to trip departure. Cancellations or changes <u>within</u> 90 days of the trip departure will be refunded only if you find a replacement, or if the Trip Captain can fill your place from the waiting list. Refunds are subject to the \$15 non-refundable deposit. Purchasing individual trip insurance is recommended.
- The Cornhusker Ski Club will not be liable for any canceled or altered services, including price increases, not initiated by the Cornhusker Ski Club.
- Children under 18 who are members with parents, are welcome on trips when accompanied by a responsible adult.
- On all the trips, the bus will not wait for latecomers on either the trip out or the trip back.
- Bunk assignments are on a first-come basis, unless stated otherwise by the Trip Captain.

- 10. No seat swapping is allowed on the bus. The same order of seating enroute will be in effect on return unless exception is made by the Trip Captain, with concurrence of all involved.
- Smoking is prohibited on the buses.
- Hallucinogens (drugs) and /or marijuana are prohibited.
 Usage will be grounds for membership dismissal. The same applies to unruly behavior or profanity.
- Lights out on return after 10:00 p.m., if the next day is a weekday.
- 14. Trips may be supplemented with drive-outs only on the condition of the bus being filled and that a hardship would not otherwise be imposed on others.
- 15. Trip Captains will have the final say on any discretionary matters. If there are any complaints, these should be reduced to writing and sent to the overall Trips Chair.
- 16. Cornhusker Ski Club is not responsible for any personal injury or property damage that may occur during a club organized function. Members assume all legal and financial responsibility for damage to any facilities used by them. If individual responsibility cannot be ascertained, cost of damages will pro-rated among room occupants. Members causing property damage can be dismissed from the club and denied new memberships as stated in the By-Laws.
- 17. The club is not responsible and shall not be liable for loss of personal property and/or delays or inconveniences sustained by any members or participant in any activity or trip arranged in whole or part by the Cornhusker Ski Club.
- At Cornhusker Ski Club meetings and functions, members are prohibited from promoting any trips or activities except those organized by the Cornhusker Ski Club.
