



Video Production with Windows Movie Maker

Becoming a Movie Mogul with Microsoft Windows Movie Maker is designed for the beginner to experience the basics of creating and editing movies. Students will learn to create movies with special effects, voice-overs, transitions, titles, credits and more. Through hands-on activities, students will work with digital video cameras to create and edit movies with Movie Maker, which is a free Microsoft video editing software.

Primary Learning Outcomes:

Students will:

- Create quality movies.
- Demonstrate storyboarding techniques in movie development.
- Demonstrate basic camera techniques.
- Learn the techniques of adding titles.
- Learn how to add sounds, music and narration.

Video Project:

Your video project needs to demonstrate the various skills and techniques that you have learned through this course. Your project should reflect an educational theme. The length of the project should be a minimum of 5 minutes and no longer than 20 minutes. In addition, your movie will include the following:

- Transitions between clips or digital pictures.
- A minimum of two digital pictures (you can find images from the Internet or use scanned images or images from a digital camera).
- Title or various titles in your movie.
- Credits for the movie creators.
- Sounds and music.
- Various video effects.
- Voice over or dubbing of audio into the video.

- Pictures or images on a disk
- External Hard Drive or Blank DVD
- Your own digital camera or camcorder (optional)
